

The rules and terms for the organizational use of Sivistys sauna

The organisations within HYY can rent the sauna as follows:

Mon-Thu €160 / 8 h (8am-4pm or 6pm-2am)

Fri-Sat €190 / 8 h (8am-4pm or 6pm-2am)

The organisations can rent the sauna for the abovementioned organisation prices twice per calendar year, which includes one Mon-Thu –reservation and one Fri-Sat –reservation. The maximum number of persons allowed in Sivistys is 40.

To rent the sauna for the organisation price, the organisation has to deliver a letter of permission when collecting the keys. The letter of permission must be signed by the person with signature rights in the organisation and confirm the organisation's commitment to rent the sauna.

The benefit is only intended for the organisation's own use. The sauna must not be booked for private persons under the name of the organisation. In case of malpractices, the organisation which has booked the sauna is billed the share of HYY in its entirety. Additionally, the opportunity to apply for the grant and to use the Student Union premises can be withheld from the organisation for the following two years. In this case, the grant is not paid for the possible valid bookings of the Student Union premises. The organisation may appeal against the decision to the Financial Committee of the HYY Board within 14 days of the decision.

HYY's user guidelines for organisational premises apply to saunas where appropriate: it is forbidden to sleep on the premises or to make any open fire. Activities in saunas may not disturb other users on the premises.

The event organiser is responsible for any broken structures, furnishings, equipment, et cetera, and for cleaning and collecting lost property after the event. Any material damage must be reported and lost property delivered to HYY's Service Office in the next weekday morning.

After the event is finished, it must be checked that all premises (including toilets) are empty and in a good order. All doors must be closed and locked with a security lock and the lights have to be turned off. The organisers are not allowed to leave any of their own or HYY's rental devices on the premises.

In addition to these rules, the organization renting the Sivistys sauna must also follow the rules given by the company operating the sauna.
